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Integrated framework for adult education providers to support social inclusion for learners with health-related conditions (acronym: INDUCATE)

The project is co-financed by the European Union.

The aim of the project: Improve the quality of education for adults with health-related conditions.

Project target group: Adult education organizations working with people with health-related conditions.

Outcomes of the project:

- an integrated system of adult education service providers that would meet the specific needs and characteristics of people with health-related conditions will be created;
- factors influencing the effectiveness of adult education for learners with health-related problems will be identified;
- an integrated system for adult education providers to assess the impact of their proposals on learners with health-related conditions will be created;
- recommendations on how to enable adult education providers to successfully meet the needs of people with health-related problems will be shared.

Project activities:

- conducting a research on factors affecting adult education effectiveness on learners with health-related conditions;
- developing an Integrated Assessment Framework & online tool for adult learning providers to measure their effectiveness on learners with health-related conditions;
- producing a road-map with recommendations for adult education providers on how to successfully address the needs of persons with health-related issues;
- organizing activities for valorization of INDUCATE results and creation of an INDUCATE network & repository of self-assessment reports, quality improvement plans and a Memorandum of Cooperation;
- holding a transnational training workshop on the use of the INDUCATE framework and the design of institution specific measures for improvement;





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- promoting INDUCATE outputs through 5 multipliers events in partner countries.

Long-term benefits: uptake and adaptation of INDUCATE Assessment Framework and Tools by adult education providers in European Union; uptake of INDUCATE framework from national bodies involved in monitoring, quality assurance and evaluation of adult education systems in Europe, with the aim to improve current monitoring techniques; participation of a growing number of adult learners with health related issues in lifelong learning programs that have been improved based on INDUCATE outputs, resulting in social inclusion or persons with health-related conditions.

The project is implemented by the Paris Lodron University in Salzburg (Austria) – project coordinator, PROMEA – Greek NGO working on EU projects, GIP-FCIP Créteil – French public interest group for basic vocational and further training, AGORA – Spanish Adult Education Association and LAAE – Lithuanian Association of Adult Education.
