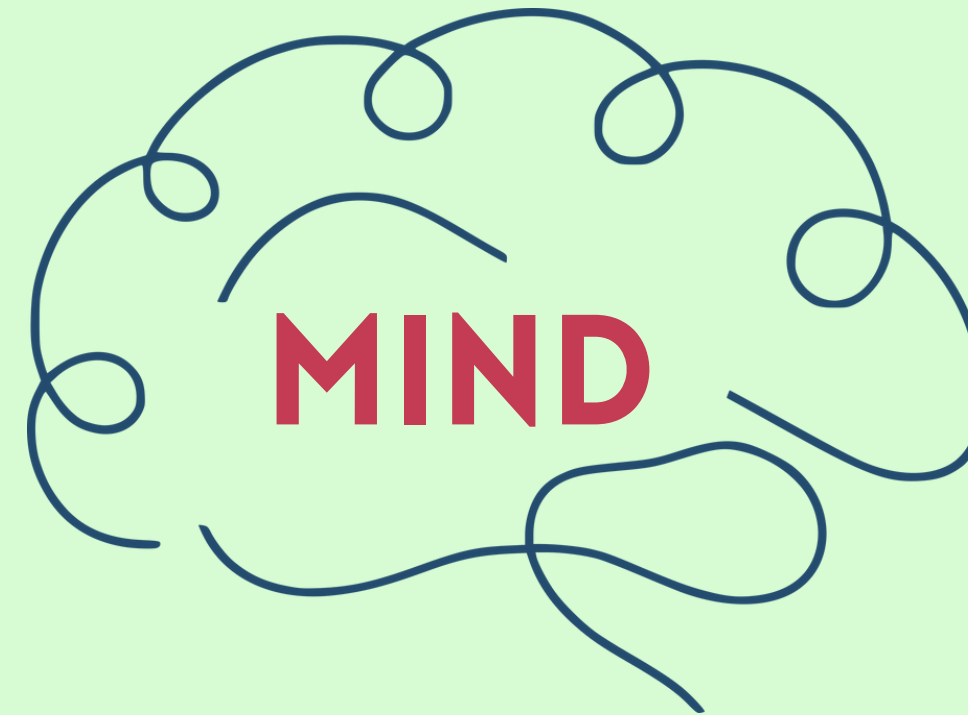

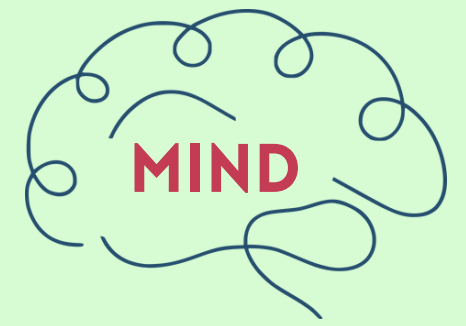
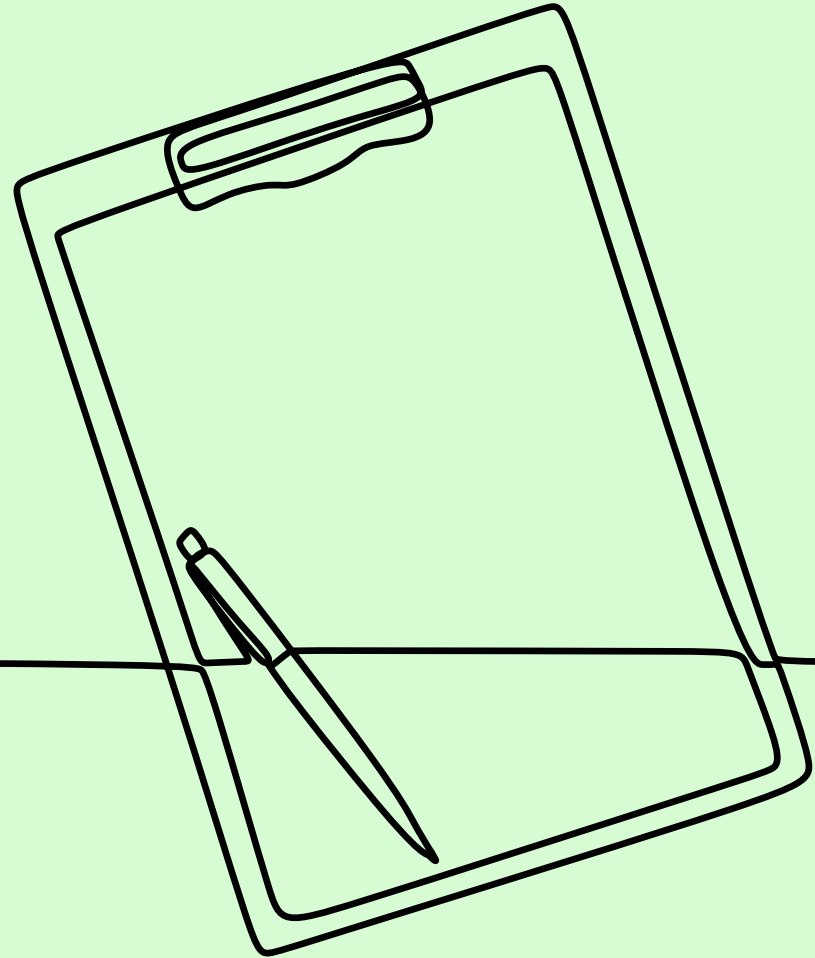
Module 4.2: Value of critical thinking for a community

3. To provide practical tools for educators to guide learners in applying critical thinking to community challenges.



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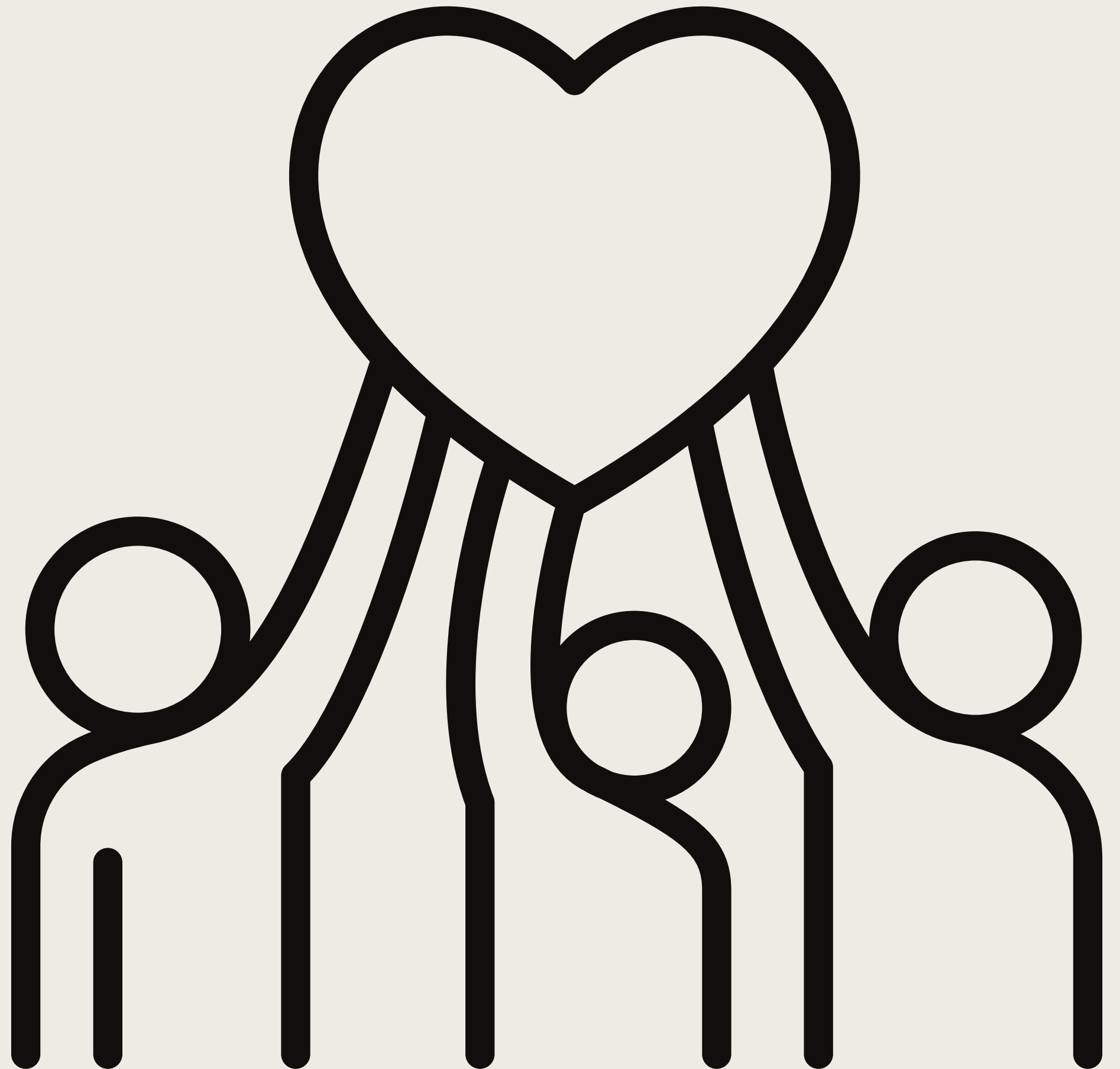

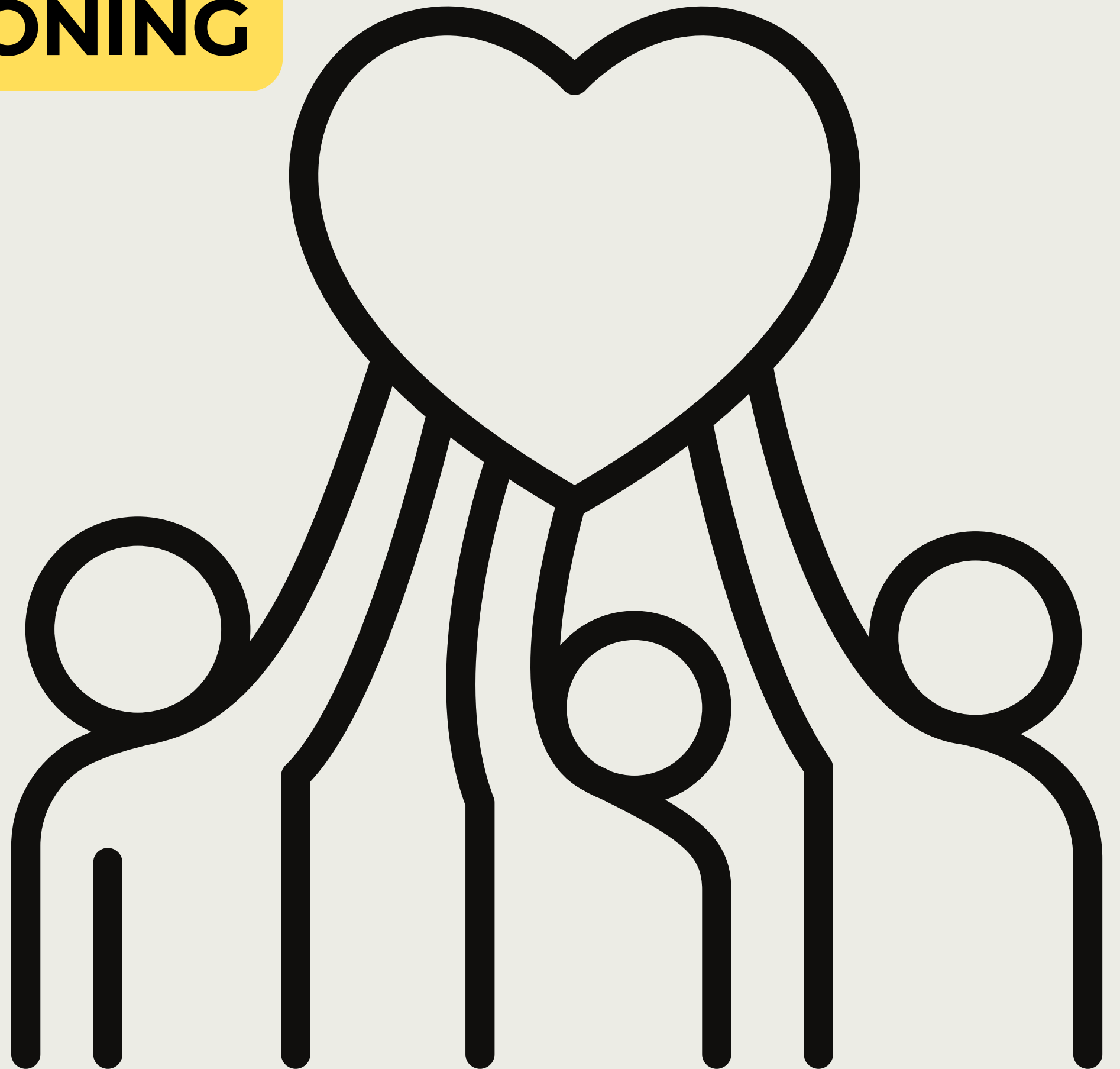

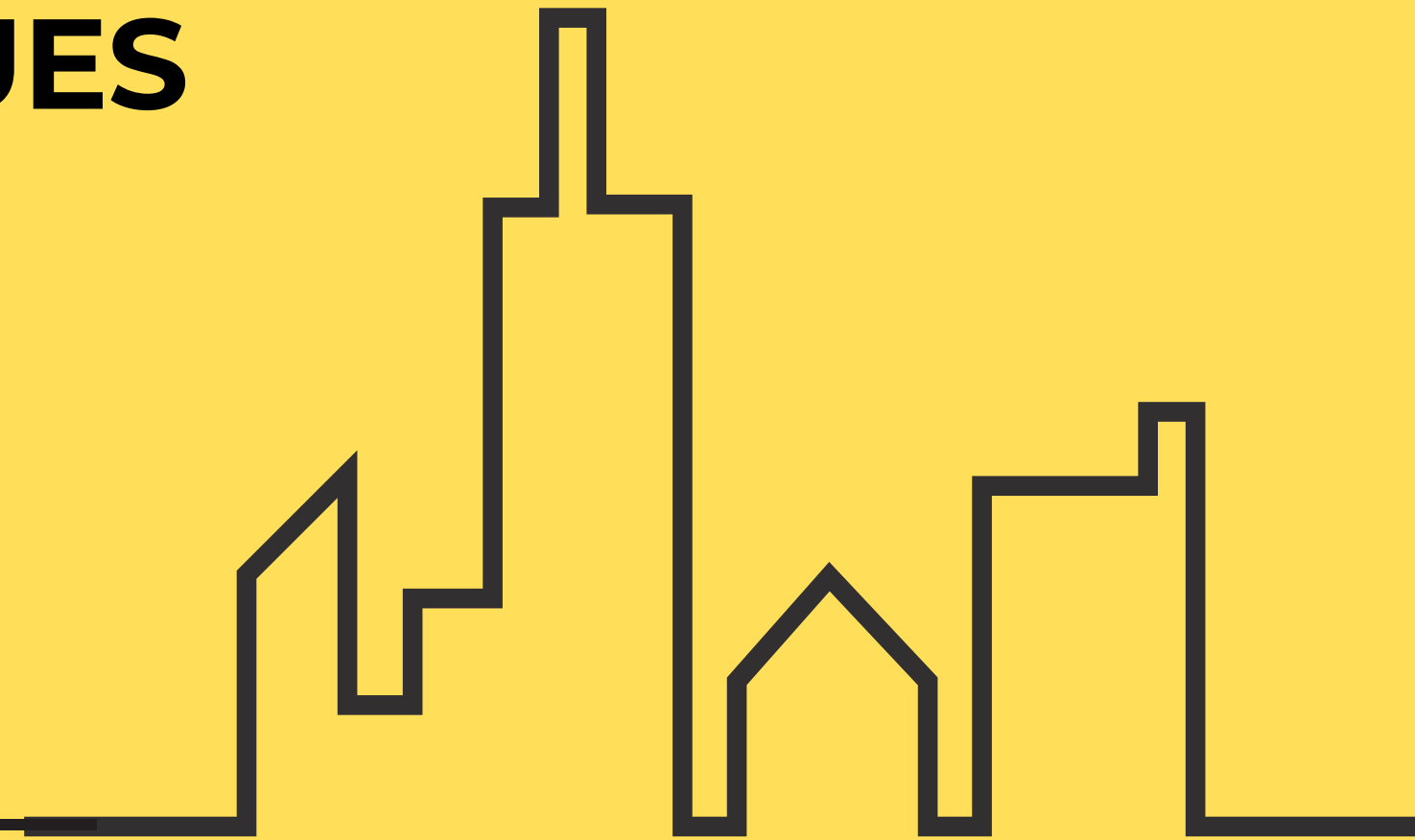

Write a list of scenarios that require critical thinking for community issues related to tolerance or traditions

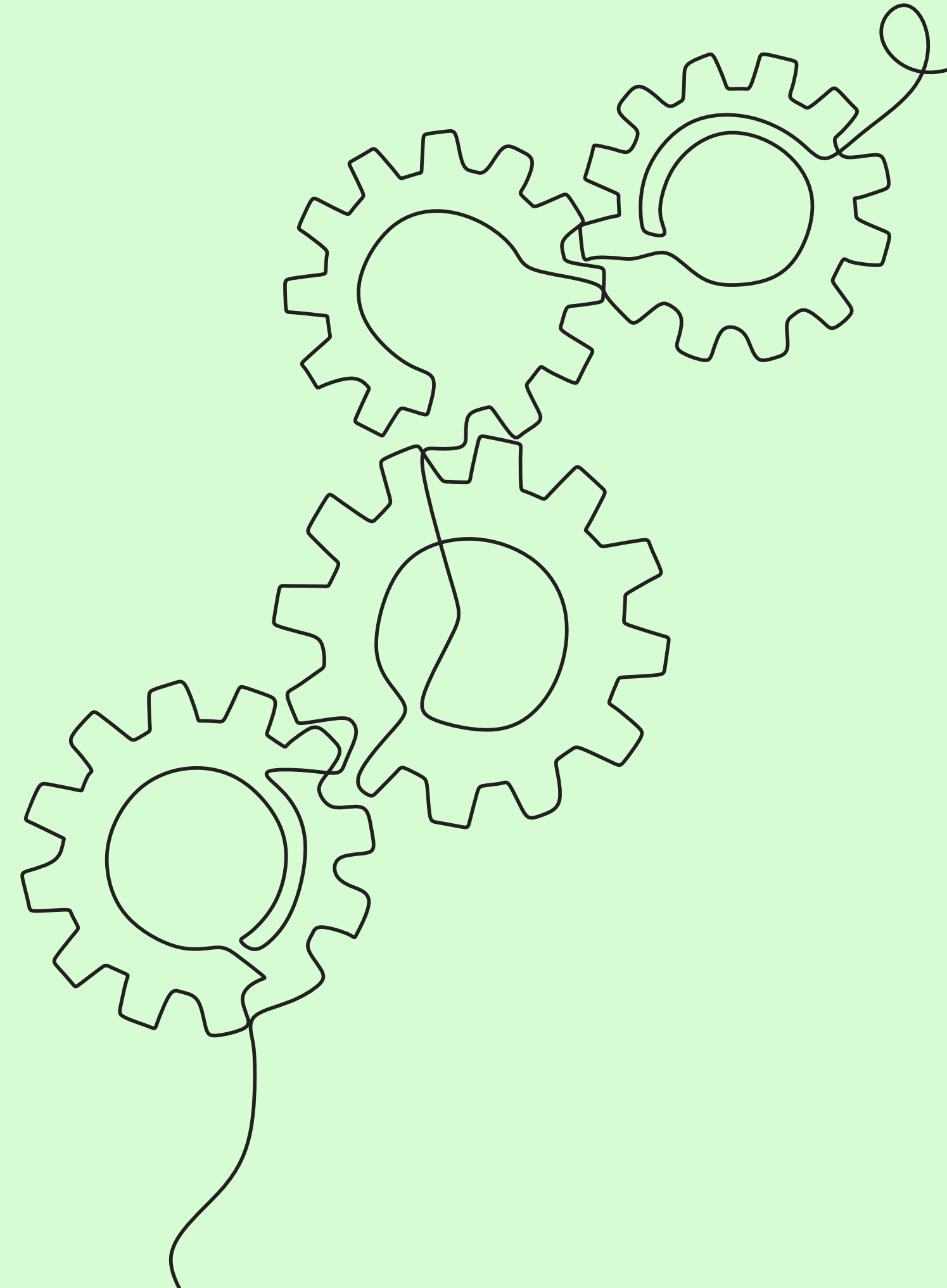
- celebrating religious or cultural holidays in public spaces

Identify a community issue/challenge related to tolerance or traditions and use the Business Model Canvas template to outline your solutions for the challenge.











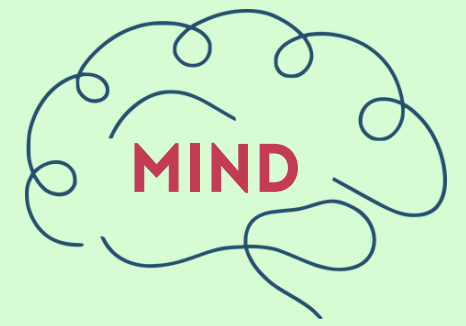

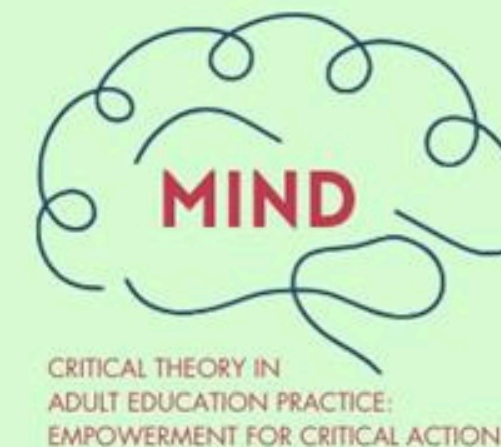
